<p><b>ITEM 2.10</b></p> <p align="center"><b>LIST OF PARTICIPATING CARRIERS</b></p> <p><b>Kansas &amp; Oklahoma Railroad, Inc. (KO)</b></p>	<p><b>ITEM 115</b></p> <p align="center"><b>PAYMENT TERMS</b></p> <p>All charges contained herein will be billed by the Kansas &amp; Oklahoma Railroad, Inc. and paid by the responsible party in U.S. funds, in full, within seven (7) days after receipt of invoice.</p> <p>A finance charge of one percent (1%) per month will apply on all invoice balances which remain unpaid beyond the payment terms prescribed in this item.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 10</b></p> <p align="center"><b>SUPPLEMENTS AND REISSUES</b></p> <p>When reference is made in this tariff, or supplements, to other publications for rates or other information, it includes "Supplements thereto or successive issues thereof."</p> <p>Where reference is made in this tariff to items, it includes "reissues" of such items.</p>	
<p><b>ITEM 20</b></p> <p align="center"><b>METHOD OF CANCELLING ITEMS</b></p> <p>As this tariff is supplemented, numbered items with letter suffixes cancel correspondingly numbered items in the original tariff, or in a prior supplement. Letter suffixes will be used in alphabetical sequence starting with A. Example: Item 100-A cancels Item 100 and Item 300-B cancels Item 300-A in a prior supplement which, in turn, cancelled Item 300.</p>	
<p align="center"><b>SECTION 1 MISCELLANEOUS RULES AND CHARGES</b></p>	
<p><b>ITEM 100</b></p> <p align="center"><b>CARS HELD FOR INSTRUCTIONS</b></p> <p>Cars, loaded or empty, held on railroad tracks for forwarding directions or other disposition, will be subject to a hold charge of \$75.00 per car per day, or fraction of a day, and will be in addition to all other applicable charges.</p> <p>Note – Not applicable on commodities covered by STCC 29 121</p>	
<p><b>ITEM 110</b></p> <p align="center"><b>CHARGE FOR MOVEMENT OF EMPTY CARS</b></p> <p>(A) After, on empty cars (1) for which the service of switching or placing the car has been performed and the car is not loaded but returned to the railroad empty or (2) which are delivered to connecting carriers empty without being preceded by a loaded move, a charge of \$100.00 per car per occurrence will be assessed and collected from the person, firm or corporation ordering such cars, and will be in addition to all other applicable charges.</p> <p>(B) Movement of empty tank cars to or from facilities for cleaning, lining, relining, maintenance, modification or repair not immediately preceded by or followed by a revenue movement via the KO will be assessed a charge of \$250.00 per car, and will be in addition to all other applicable charges.</p> <p>(C) Movement of empty cars to or from Rescar at Wichita, KS for cleaning, relining, maintenance, modifications or repair will be assessed a charge of \$150.00 per car per move, and will be in addition to all other applicable charges</p>

**ITEM 145**

**CHARGES FOR DELAY OF CARS**

A receiving carrier refusing to accept cars when offered by the KO shall pay a delay charge of \$50.00 per day for each refused car. Such charges will be in addition to all other applicable charges.

**ITEM 150**

**MILEAGE ALLOWANCE ON SHIPPER OWNED  
OR LEASED CARS**

Shipper owned or leased cars moving under freight rates published in this tariff or in any connecting line tariff will be zero rated on the KO.
